Naples, FL – Peter D. Richter is taking a stand for liberty so that our children do not have to bow in slavery. On April 30, 2012 Libertarian candidate Peter D. Richter had the pleasure of attending the April meeting of the SWFL 9.12 Project. Richter, who is a frequent attendee of the 9.12 meetings, was invited to speak about his candidacy and to answer questions from the group of concerned, local citizens in attendance.

The SWFL 9.12 Project exists to unite, educate, and take action to preserve the U.S. Constitution and founding principles so it was a natural fit for Richter. Richter has pledged to uphold individual liberty, private property rights, and economic freedom here in Florida while also protecting Floridians from unconstitutional federal government overreach like the NDAA and "Obamacare."

"It seems like my opponent has never met a big government boondoggle that she didn't vote for. 'The price of freedom is eternal vigilance.' When I'm up in Tallahassee the people of Naples, Marco Island, and Everglades City in District 106 will be able to sleep soundly at night knowing that I will never let an unconstitutional, big government, establishment piece of legislation slip through the cracks without doing everything I can to prevent it," Richter said.

During his speech Richter talked about how his two young daughters inspired him to run for office to ensure that they have the same liberties and freedoms that we have been able to enjoy our whole lives. Richter received significant applause from the attendees when he discussed ending the stranglehold that certain regulations have over small businesses in Collier County and why we need to return control over education to our local communities and most importantly to

parents themselves. "My opponent voted to **ban** parents from the text book selection process when she voted in favor of SB 2120 which took effect in July 2011. If she doesn't trust parents to make decisions about the education of their own children how can we trust her to Stand for Liberty?" asked Richter.
