officially qualified for the November ballot**

Naples, FL – Peter D. Richter is taking a stand for liberty so that our children do not have to bow in slavery. Peter D. Richter officially qualified for the ballot last week for District 106 in the November general election.

As a candidate for the Florida House of Representatives, District 106, Peter D. Richter continues to be the only candidate who has the courage to Stand for Liberty. Out of the three candidates who officially qualified for the ballot Richter was the only candidate to do so by the petition method. The petition method for the Florida House race requires that a candidate receive signatures from over 518 individuals in order to be placed on the ballot as opposed to paying a qualifying fee to be placed on the ballot without any signature gathering.

“I think it demonstrates the strong level of popular support that I have in Collier County’s District 106. I have said from the very beginning of my campaign that I will not be afraid to go to the people, to discuss issues with them, to defend their rights and liberties, and to represent them to the best of my abilities in Tallahassee. It seemed only natural that in order to qualify for the ballot that I go face to face with the citizens of Collier County and ask for their support and I am so thankful they answered with an emphatic “Yes!” On the other hand, my opponents couldn’t get 518 votes from Floridians to support their efforts to get on the ballot or perhaps it was too hard to talk to the people they want to represent and ask for their support. I guess it was just easier for them to fling money at an issue and make it go away,” stated Richter.

Richter continued, “Do you want to elect a candidate who has shown that he’ll go to the people and listen to the concerns of local citizens or do you want to elect another big government candidate whose only solution to any problem is to throw money at it? We have enough politicians in Tallahassee and Washington, D.C. who prefer to waste our money rather than come up with real solutions.”
